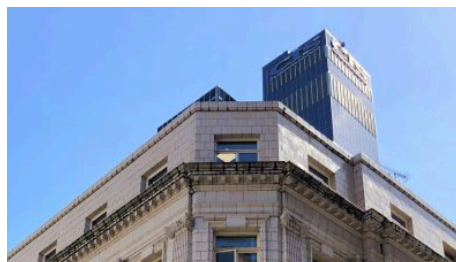
ORGANIZERS

The **Co-operative College of the Philippines** partner of **CLIMBS Life and General Insurance Cooperative** (started in 1971, founded by the late Atty. Mordino Cua and Atty. Aquilino Pimentel Sr., CLIMBS provides service protection to its 4,000 member-owners in the Philippines) and the **National Federation of Cooperatives in the Philippines (NaFeCoop)**.

CCPH originated as the CLIMBS Institute of Financial Literacy (CIFL) in November 2011, providing education for cooperative managers and future leaders. In 2019, it became the CLIMBS Institute of Management (CIM), expanding its focus to financial literacy and leadership training. Officially registered with the SEC on August 20, 2021, the college held its soft launch on October 28, 2021, during "Cooperative Talks 2021." On July 7, 2022, the CIM transitioned to CCPH during its first Board of Trustees meeting in Cebu City. Moreover, CCPH is the leading partner of CLIMBS and NaFeCoop in providing cooperative education to its member owners.

The **Co-operative College** is a British educational charity dedicated to the promotion of co-operative values, ideas, and principles within co-operatives, communities, and society.

The Co-operative College was established in 1919 by the Co-operative Union with ten overseas students based on the second floor of Holyoake House, Manchester, and in 1943 the College became a charitable trust.

Manchester city centre is the central business district of Manchester, England, within the confines of Great Ancoats Street, A6042 Trinity Way, and A57 Mancunian Way, which collectively form an inner ring road.
